The Defendant, his agents, employees and assigns are hereby enjoined and prohibited from engaging in unlicensed activity as described in NRS Chapter 489. Specifically, Defendant may not perform any of the functions of a general serviceperson as described in NRS 489.102, unless and until he has applied for and been issued a general serviceperson license by the Division.

ADMINISTRATIVE FINE

As part of this Stipulation, Defendant agrees to pay the Division a fine in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for his violations of the Division's Cease and Desist Order in violation of NRS 489.436 and engaging in unlicensed activity in violation of NRS 489.311 and/or NRS 489.806. This fine shall be paid in four monthly installments, with the first payment to be paid within thirty (30) days after the Court's Order approving this Stipulation. The three remaining installments shall be paid every thirty days thereafter.

Based on the Stipulation between the parties, after the Court approves this Stipulation and signs the accompanying Order, this matter will be resolved, and the parties agree that a trial on the merits will not be necessary.


