Manufactured Housing Division Summarily Suspends Specialty Serviceman's License of Marlowe Fuller

Carson City – The Manufactured Housing Division has announced that the specialty serviceman's license of Henderson-based Marlowe Fuller has been summarily suspended.

The Manufactured Housing Division, through their investigation, found that Fuller was indicted of a felony. As a result, in the interest of the safety of the public, Mr. Fuller's license was suspended pursuant NRS 233B.127(3).

A specialty serviceman is any person who is a licensed contractor and performs repairs on or in manufactured homes, mobile homes or commercial coaches in air conditioning, plumbing and heating, electrical, roofing/skirting/awning. Fuller's license was for Air Conditioning and Refrigeration, so he is prohibited from engaging in any repair activities related to A/C and refrigeration.

One of the requirements of a specialty serviceman license is to hold a valid contractor's license, and Mr. Fuller's contractor's license has also been suspended.

"The Division strives to act quickly when we uncover violations of NRS," said Manufactured Housing Administrator Jim deProse. *"We will not tolerate unethical behavior on the part of our licensees."*
